In our programs, the girls are learning skills that will make them better, stronger, and smarter workers. They will have knowledge and experiences that help them be more empathetic, better at problem solving, do better in school than their peers, and are less likely to experiment with or use drugs, alcohol, and tobacco products. Our girls will grow up to be strong, smart, and bold in all aspects of their life.

Girls Inc. girls grow up Strong, Smart, and Bold:



MAKE HEALTHY CHOICES

- 77% of Girls Inc. high school girls say they are happy with their bodies, compared to 48% nationally.
- 11% of Girls Inc. high school girls have used cigarettes, compared to 31% nationally.
- 96% of Girls Inc. teens say “getting pregnant would interfere with school.”

SUCCEED ACADEMICALLY

- 79% of Girls Inc. teens are on track to graduate high school on time.
- 95% of Girls Inc. girls say they care about doing well in school.
- 82% of Girls Inc. girls plan to attend college.

GROW UP TO BE INDEPENDENT

- 90% of Girls Inc. girls are hopeful about their futures.
- 92% of Girls Inc. teens say they can use what they know to solve “real-life” problems in their communities.
- 83% of Girls Inc. girls do what they believe is right, even if their friends make fun of them.

URGENT NEEDS

- 1 IN 5 GIRLS in the US live in poverty
- 21.8% of Wayne County children under 18 live in poverty
- 1 in 5 children face food insecurity in Wayne County (22.3%)
- 1 IN 6 GIRLS will not finish high school. Students from low-income families are 5X MORE LIKELY to drop out of high school
- ONLY 48% of High School girls are happy with their bodies
- OVER 1 in 20 US teen girls become pregnant each year
- 1 in 4 GIRLS experience sexual abuse or assault by the age of 17
- 9,854 CHILDREN are enrolled in Wayne County schools alone - they don't all have a safe afterschool place or program

SCOPE AND SCALE TO LEAD A MOVEMENT AND CREATE POSITIVE CHANGE FOR GIRLS

- Affiliate of a Network of 75 affiliates in the US & Canada
- Girls Inc. of Wayne County is an Affiliate of the Girls Inc. Network and we:
- Serve girls ages 5 to 18 between on-site (K-10th grade) and in-school programming (3-12th grade)
- Offer services in 2 counties (Wayne and Union) and are currently looking to expand services
- Serve more than 14 schools currently
- Serve over 200 girls at the center
- Serve over 2000 kids in our community
- Around 50% of our girls live in a household with a reported income of under \$50,000

Girls Inc. inspires all girls to be **STRONG, SMART, and BOLD**, providing girls with life-changing experiences and solutions to the unique challenges they face.

We support girls through a comprehensive approach to whole girl development which equips girls to navigate gender, economic, and social barriers. This approach helps lift girls out of poverty.

Without supportive gender-specific programming, many of the girls we serve are at high risk for being sex-trafficked, becoming pregnant, using drugs, dropping out of school, and breaking the law.
